## LEVEL 2 INTERMEDIATE APPRENTICESHIP

### Entry Requirements

Intermediate Apprentices will need GCSE or Functional Skills in Maths and English.

### Qualifications to be completed

- Level 2 Diploma in Health and Social Care (Adults) for England
- Level 2 Certificate in Preparing to Work in Adult Social Care
- Level 1 Functional Skills English
- Level 1 Functional Skills Maths
- Employment Rights and Responsibilities
- Personal Learning and Thinking Skills

### Length of programme

12 months

### Mandatory modules

- Introduction to Communication in Health, Social Care or Children's and Young People's Settings
- Introduction to Personal Development in Health, Social Care or Children's and young People's Settings
- Introduction to Equality and Inclusion in Health, Social Care or Children's and Young People's Settings
- Introduction to Duty of Care in Health, Social Care of Children's and Young People's Settings
- Principles of Safeguarding and Protection in Health and Social Care
- The Role of the Health and Social Care Worker 97 Unit 7: Implement Person-Centred Approaches in Health and Social Care 102 Unit 8: Contribute to Health and Safety in Health and Social Care
- Handle Information in Health and Social Care Settings

### Example optional modules

- The Principles of Infection Prevention and Control
- Support Care Plan Activities
- Support Individuals to Eat and Drink
- Support Individuals to Meet Personal Care Needs
- Support Individuals to Manage Continence

### Day-to-day activities

Tasks undertaken by apprentices will vary depending on the level and sector in which they are employed. Tasks may include undertaking personal care such as assistance with dressing, feeding, washing and toileting, providing advice, encouragement and emotional and psychological support.

### Assessment

Apprentices will be required to produce evidence using e-portfolio software. A Skills Coach will visit once a month to observe apprentices. Some diploma units and functional skills include tests which need to be taken at a training centre.
