LEVEL 2 INTERMEDIATE APPRENTICESHIP

Entry Requirements

There are no mandatory entry requirements for Intermediate apprentices, GCSE English and Maths A-D are recommended along with an interest in working with children and young people

Qualifications to be completed

- Level 2 Certificate in Children and Young People's Workforce
- Level 1 Functional Skills English
- Level 1 Functional Skills Math
- Level 1 Functional Skills ICT
- Employment Rights and Responsibilities
- Personal Learning and Thinking Skills

Length of programme

12-15 months

Mandatory modules

- Contribute to the support of children and young people's development
- Contribute to children and young people's health and safety
- Contribute to the support of positive environments
- Contribute to Partnership working in children and young people's settings
- Introduction to communication in children and young people's settings
- Introduction to personal development in children and young people's settings
- Introduction to equality and inclusion in children and young people's settings
- Child and young person's development
- Safeguarding the welfare of children and young people
- Maintain and support positive relationships with children and young people
- Support children and young people's positive behaviour

Example optional modules

- Contribute to the support of children's communication, language and literacy
- Contribute to the support of children's creative development
- Support children and young people at meal or snack times
- Develop positive relationships with children and young people and others involved in their care
- Support children and young people with disabilities and special educational needs
- Brand development

Day-to-day activities

Tasks will include working under the direction of a supervisor providing care at Level 2. All apprentices will be delivering the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum, maintaining the welfare and safety of the child or young person.

Assessment

Apprentices will be required to produce evidence using e-portfolio software. A Skills Coach will visit once a month to observe apprentices. Some diploma units and functional skills include tests which need to be taken at a training centre.

- Nursery assistant in a pre-school
- Private day nursery or school nursery
- Childminder
- Out of school playworker
- Creche assistant
