



TEACHING ASSISTANTS

LEVEL 3 ADVANCED APPRENTICESHIP

Entry Requirements

Advanced Apprentices will need GCSE or Functional Skill Maths English and ICT qualification and have experience of working as a Teaching Assistant and a Level 2 qualification in Supporting Teaching and Learning.

Qualifications to be completed

- Level 3 Diploma in Specialist Support for Teaching and Learning in Schools
- Level 2 Functional Skills English
- Level 2 Functional Skills Maths
- Level 2 Functional Skills ICT
- Employment Rights and Responsibilities
- Personal Learning and Thinking Skills

Length of programme

15 months

Mandatory modules

- Communication and professional relationships with children, young people and adults
- Schools as organisations
- Understand child and young person development
- Understand how to safeguard the wellbeing of children and young people
- Support learning activities
- Promote children and young people's positive behaviour
- Develop professional relationships with children, young people and adults
- Promote equality, diversity and inclusion in work with children and young people
- Support assessment for learning
- Engage in personal development
- Support children and young people's health and safety

Example optional modules

- Support literacy development
- Support numeracy development
- Support delivery of the 14-19 curriculum
- Support pupils cognition and learning needs
- Supervise children on journeys, visits and activities outside the setting

Day-to-day activities

Tasks may include working under the direction or alongside the teacher to support the whole class, working with individual and small groups of pupils, contributing to planning, implementing and evaluating learning activities. Occasional whole class cover may be required in the absence of the teacher

Assessment

Apprentices will be required to produce evidence using e-portfolio software. Apprentices will be required to attend a training centre one half-day per fortnight for training. A Skills Coach will maintain contact with the apprentice and school, arranging regular reviews and observation in the workplace. Functional Skills tests will also take place at the training centre.
